Phoenix Industrial Contracting, visited your property on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2019 to verify Seneca Insurance's inspection. Are findings are listed below.

- *Each dwelling unit is individually fed from a pad mounted transformer to the meter located on the side or the front of the unit. Combination meter boxes are NOT used therefor, a single aluminum feeder originating at the pad mount transformer pigtailed to feed multiple meters does not exist.*
- *Each dwelling unit is fed from its meter to its panel with aluminum feeders, and all branch circuits within are copper.*
